#### 7. CHARGE AND SPECIFICATION (S)

On 20Aug12 at 2336, Major Busa, B submitted the following PAF Message requesting a discharge from the 7th Cavalry Regiment.

"I came back thinking that I was returning to family. I was told that I would be back to my old rank after 4 months. I keep hearing that rank doesn't mean shit and that all the people who care know me as Busa and that is all that counts. I was an LTC when I left being drawn away by bullshit by Aaron because what I can donate. I fucked up. I came back saying I fucked up. Now I am at the whim of an individual that has guit the Cav twice and come back at the same rank or higher (second time he quit he did come back at a higher rank). All this happened under the "Plumbly years", the time that all are so willing to dismiss. The only reason the dam built in front of my promotion (the rank of this individual) is because of those "Plumbly years". I was under this persons command then and they DID NOT DO SHIT! It is still this way. This person did not do a single background check as OIC or a member of S2 and admitted this to me and his response was "so what, what are you getting at". It seems very unfair that all of the other members of the Cav are held to a certain standard yet the leadership can do and come and go as they please. I was away for 4 DAYS! 2 weeks for the other and not a peep. I have busted my ass for the Cav in the past and have done as much as I have been able to, spending much of my very limited free time to work at what I was assigned to. Taking time away from my wife and other family, true family members. That seems to be not enough for me at least. I have heard that "rank doesn't mean shit" from too many in leadership, which is easy to say at the top. And I challenge you. If you truly believe that statement, renounce your rank and everyone else's. Only then will that statement hold true. All know that inside of a Military realism clan that the rank signify's accomplishment and tenure. It shows the new guys that you have been here and did what you had to do to earn respect from your peers. So I am tired of the "rank doesn't mean shit argument" because you Goddamn know it does. And the "Plumbly years" are when and how the "leadership" got to where they are. Some by merit and some not. It seems pretty obvious that I am talking about those that have not got there by merit. I have been dicked with enough by someone that does nothing but delegate and can't even do that properly. Yes Bahama that is you. You had us come to a 2 hour meeting where you did not do or anything. Then disconnected. You are "on the road and don't have good internet connection" and that is why you haven't made the post for my promotion, when you have been on just about every day active on the forums and your home IP came up for the post you made today. I guess this will make you smile because I no longer will be here. But I hope everyone else will now see YOU DON'T DO A FUCKING THING! Later. Erase all of my info. I don't want a trace of my existence left in the Cav. This was supposed to be an escape from the day to day bullshit that I have to deal with but thanks to a certain few it has created nothing but stress. And you know what the fucked up thing is? It was done to do just that. You should really be ashamed of yourself, screwing with people like that. That is not the action of a man it is the action of a coward."

In submitting the PAF above, Major Busa, B. violated several articles of the 7th Cavalry UCMJ, the 7th Cavalry Code of Conduct, and lastly the 7th Cavalry General Orders. Compounding the situation, the PAF system is a public system and this message was broadcast for any and all members to see. These actions lack courage or honor and set a poor example for lower rank members to emulate.

The following is a summary of charges:

Article 88 - Contempt toward another member of 7th Cavalry

- Code of Conduct, Article II
- Any commissioned officer who uses contemptuous words against any other member of the 7th Cavalry Regiment, regardless of rank, shall be punished as a court-martial may direct.

• Any person subject to this chapter who behaves with disrespect toward his superior commissioned officer shall be punished as a court-martial may direct.

Article 90 - Assaulting or willfully disobeying superior commissioned officer

- Any person subject to this chapter who—
- (1) assaults his superior commissioned officer by written attacks by any medium while he is in the execution of his office;

Article 133 - Conduct unbecoming an officer and a gentleman

Any commissioned officer who is convicted of conduct unbecoming an officer and a gentleman shall be punished as a court-martial may direct.

I find that the accused has knowingly, intelligently, and consciously waived his rights against self-incrimination, to a trial of the facts by a court-martial, and to be confronted by the witnesses against him; that the accused is, in fact guilty; and his plea of guilty is accepted.

The charges under Articles 117 and 134, are hereby dropped.

## Sentence:

Lieutenant Colonel Busa, B. with consideration of your time in service and contributions to the 7th Cavalry Regiment, and in accordance with your pleas of guilty, this court-martial finds you guilty of all charges and specifications and sentences you to be reduced to the rank of Captain.

Accordingly, the approved findings and sentences are AFFIRMED.
