RE: LETTER OF REPRIMAND

1. In case of 7th Cavalry Regiment vs. First Lieutenant Walter Rocknowski, the court panel have elected to dismiss the case with prejudice, as it was determined that the charges brought did not rise to the level expected of the proceedings.
2. The agreement to dismiss the charges is made with an understanding, that the judgment shown on your part, and your demonstrated understanding of policies and procedures which an officer of your grade and billet should have intimate knowledge over, was woefully inadequate and left much to be desired.
3. Your request for retirement is being honored.
4. If you elect to return from retirement in the future, you will be required to attend developmental counselling and successfully complete the Officer Development Program, once it is on offer.
5. It is understood, that the court is being gracious in its decision to dismiss the case, and should you come before the court again due to concerns over ethics, or conduct, it is understood that the court will be disinclined to show the same compassion.
